100% POLYETHYLENE PRODUCTS

All wallcoverings are subject to soiling and wear and require a regular program of maintenance.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Vacuum with an upholstery attachment or use a soft nylon brush for removal of dry dirt and grime. Common commercial stains such as scuff marks, heel marks and soiling often can be removed completely with a dry brush.

CLEANING CODES

X = Vacuum Only

W = Water-based cleaners

WS = Water-based Solvent

BC = Bleach Cleanable (10% solution)

WS & BC = Water/solvent & bleach cleanable

KETCHUP	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
MUSTARD	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
COFFEE	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
TEA	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
ORANGE JUICE	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
GRAPE JUICE	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
BUTTER	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
CRAYON	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry. Clean with 409 if necessary.
CLEAR/CLAY BASED ADHESIVE	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry.
PERMANENT MARKER	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry.
DIRT	Clean with hot soapy water, towel dry.
BALLPOINT PEN	Clean with pencil eraser. Wash with hot soapy water, towel dry.
